## **Good practices for the inclusion of people with disabilities in electoral processes**

**Meredith Applegate** is a senior international development professional with over 15 years of experience in election assistance and democracy programming across Asia, Eastern Europe, Latin America, and Africa. She has partnered with election management bodies, civil society organizations, and government institutions to advance inclusive electoral processes, civic engagement, and gender equality. Meredith co-founded Partnerships for Integrity (P4I) last year with five other women, an international non-profit focused on good governance, accountability, human rights, and inclusion.

Throughout her career she has championed the political participation of marginalized communities — including women, persons with disabilities, Indigenous peoples, and youth — and has published widely on topics ranging from gender equality in elections to disability-inclusive election technology. She holds an MSc in Gender, Development and Globalization from the London School of Economics and a BA in International Studies and English Literature from Northwestern University.
